This file is approximately 64 pages.

See dir.wpd or pdf for a listing of over 1,500 family files with over 13,500 references. Reference numbers, shown as superscripts, document over 13,500 sources such as books, tombstones, deeds, etc where data may be found and are identified in my ref or ref2 files. With the ref file about 3,400 pages it became necessary to start a ref2 file with references above 12,500 so they could be sent by email. We also have a refimages file of over 12,500 entries mostly photos and their identification.

John W. Carver wrote a Blackwell family book and gave it to the Pickens County, GA Blackwell family (his in laws).

Introduction

The material presented here is a working copy of my data at this time. Some material contained herein is repeated as it comes from various sources and it needs to be combined, when possible, but in some cases conflicts in data are obvious and no resolution can be made. All data is to be taken with the usual "pinch of doubt" and all data should be subject to verification and correction. No doubt some of this data will be wrong. I have tried to document with superscripts some source for the information and if possible at least a second source for any given piece of data. At times these are missing simply due to lack of space on a line. Two separate reference files ref & ref2 documents the over 13,500 references used to construct the various files. A given family file is meant to be both a documentation of my family, relatives, or neighbors of my families, etc. Each file is also a place to store any data I have collected on those with the same name who may or may not be related. No index is available.

Word Perfect was originally chosen because no genealogy program has the flexibility to do all I wanted to do with each family. Now I have a vast amount of material, over 57,500 typed pages. In total I still like the flexibility of Word Perfect and continue to keep all my data there or in the two Excel files sorted by name and by cemetery. At present all of the family files are in Word Perfect wpd format. These files are also kept in PDF, Adobe format for those who cannot read Word Perfect files. Any of these files may be obtained from the author, but I strongly prefer to send them attached to email.

Cautions: Dates are shown as month-day-year! We use a style of graphics to show the relationships. Where a lot of deeds, etc, have the same name they may not be places with the correct person - example in Spartanburg, SC there were at least two Robert White. Deeds for both may be shown under one Robert White unless we know a way to differentiate them. Talking Rock which is in Pickens County, GA does have mailing addresses that are in Gilmer County, GA. Also Acworth in Cobb County, GA has an address in Cherokee County, GA. See our Excel files, byname and bycem each with over 4,000 pages containing over 28,500 names sorted by either name or cemetery and containing cemetery records, death records, obituaries, and census, military or draft records, whatever we could find and fit related to people related to Cherokee County, GA, a number of these graves are unmarked and not documented in cemetery books. We note errors in some books not that we will not have our share but to allow people to know correct and incorrect data.

Overview

My genealogy data now comprises over 1,500 family files varying from a few lines to files over 1,000 pages and over 1,700 pages on the **Ingram** family lines alone; each of the two Excel files is over 4,000 pages; 13 family files contain over 500 pages each and 5 files contain over 1,000 pages each. See my file dir.wpd for a listing of the individual files and their size. I freely share these files and will provide them in either Word Perfect, wpd, or Adobe, pdf format. I use Word Perfect and freely attach these files to email if requested in wpd or Adobe pdf format. I can load all of my data and files onto a 128 G-byte thumb drive for serious researchers or groups, a 64 G-byte will not hold all the material and photos. IT MUST BE A USB 3 drive.

The files I have are documented with superscripts showing where either the data can be found, or tombstones, photos, etc. We now list over 13,500 referenced items and my reference file, ref.wpd, itself now totals over 3,400 pages and stops at 12,500 references. Ref2 contains references above 12,500. My refimages file with photos and descriptions now totals over 12,500 photos or related items; over 19,000 tombstones organized by State/County/ Cemetery, with over 16,000 more typed index cards done by John Carver 1976-9 documenting Cherokee County, GA tombstones; over 260 "In Loving Memory Cards" and over 12,500 referenced images and their descriptions. Due to cost of both money and time due to large size of the photo files. I try to limit sending only a few photos attached to email to any one person. You have to cut a DVD, not CD, to store a reasonable number of the photos and a thumb drive works much better for me. Again, I welcome additions or corrections and firmly state all data is to be taken as something to verify, as even one of my grandmother's Bibles had my mothers birth date recorded wrong. Where I find serious question or conflicts in data I will usually try to indicate it.

Reference numbers, shown as superscripts, document over 13,500 sources such as books, tombstones, deeds, etc where data may be found and are identified in my ref or ref2 files.

In December of 2009, five DVD's of material from this collection was submitted to the LDS because of their vast resources and willingness to share material. In January 2010 this material was accepted by the LDS and will be released by them but that material is now out of date material. The data found here in my files will be the latest material as it is constantly updated as long as I am able.

Only superscripts do not print as such if this data is posted on my Facebook site - North Georgia Genealogy

wpd the extension of all my Word Perfect files, this is the program I use for all my family data, but I also save each file in PDF, Adobe format for people who do not use Word Perfect (Photos are usually show in JPG format.) Note WP has an annoying feature it may change format on saving

pdf the alternate extension for all my family files, I make the files in Word Perfect and save them in both WPD and PDF formats

Excel Excel is a Microsoft spread sheet program, we have two of these files are each over 4,000 pages and containing over 28,500 names sorted by both name (one file - byname) and by cemetery (bycemetery)

Note we freely share all our 1,500 family files and 30,000 plus photos. We have has a number of Italian marble workers in the area and some tombstone have the dates in Italian. Here is and Italian to English translation of names for months.

I do NOT use a period after Mr, Mrs, Dr, Jr, Sr, etc as I feel strongly that this makes the reading harder, not improving it. I use a colon to start a list and a semicolon to separate items in a list, especially if they contain addresses and a common, as I think it make it much easier to follow and read. It is common now NOT to state people were cremated as is common so we must assume if the obituary states someone had a memorial service with no burial data that they were cremated.
